Net Control will take check-ins on the linked Big Island DMR repeaters on talkgroup 31153 "Hawaii County"

The net will start at 11:45 am on the Hawaii County DMR repeaters: Ocean view, Honaunau, Pahala, Kailua-Kona, Kaloko, Mauna Loa, Haleakala and Kaumana repeaters.

[When checking in please give net control the following information; your callsign, first name, & general location. For example: "This is KH7MS, Blake Princess Kaiulani and Tiki siren heard weak."](#) Nearest cross streets, or well known locations or buildings and if you heard the siren, strong, weak or not at all.
